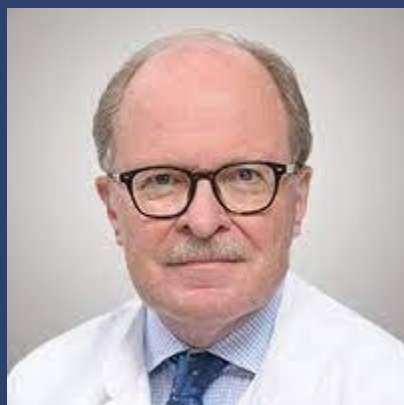

**Christian Gerber, MD, PhD, FRCS (hon)** is Professor and Chairman emeritus of the Department of Orthopaedics at the University of Zürich.

After Medical School at Berne and Yale and internships in Neurology, Internal Medicine General Surgery, Pr Christian Gerber was trained in orthopaedics in Berne, Paris, and San Antonio. He was appointed Professor and Chair at the Cantonal Hospital Fribourg in 1992 and to the University of Zürich in 1995. He received an honorary degree of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, an honorary PhD of the university Sapienza in Rome in 2024, is member of the Swiss Academy of medical Sciences, honorary member of multiple national societies and has authored over 480 peer – reviewed publications which have been cited over 54'000 times and resulted in a H-index of 121 (Google Scholar).

He is the only four times winner of the Charles S. Neer Award, the first non-American winner of the Kappa Delta Award of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons and recipient of the Arthur Steindler Award of the Orthopaedic Research Society. In 2000, he created the ResOrtho Foundation for Orthopaedic Research and Education which has supported young academic careers and was the founder of Balgrist Campus, a novel infrastructure for orthopaedic research and development in Zürich.
